Under typical UK conditions, 1m² of PV panel will produce around 100kWh electricity per year, so it would take around 2.5 years to "pay back" the energy cost of the panel. PV panels have an expected life of least 25 to 30 years, so even under UK conditions a PV panel will generate many times more energy than was needed to manufacture it.

Some common solar panel system sizes include a 3kW solar panel system, a 4 kilowatt solar panel system and a 5kW solar panels. For instance, a typical 2kW solar panel system suited for 1-3 people will need anywhere between 5 and 8 solar panels (for 350W panels).

A typical 4kW solar panel system for 2-3 bedroom houses costs $\text{R}5,000 - \text{R}6,000$ with installation. Added together, the total cost of solar panels and a battery in the UK is $\text{R}13,000 - \text{R}15,500$. A 4kW system breaks even in 7 - 10 years, with annual electricity cost savings of between $\text{R}440$ and $\text{R}1,005$.
