How long is a solar panel warranty?

Solar panel warranties vary depending on the manufacturer, but in the solar industry, a 10-year product warranty and a 25-year performance warranty are typically considered the minimum standard. The warranty typically covers the solar panels themselves, as well as the inverters and other components of the solar panel system. The warranty may also cover the labor and materials used in the installation of the panels, as well as any defects or issues that may arise with the panels during the warranty period.

How long do power panels last?

Power warranties typically extend beyond product warranties, with most manufacturers offering coverage for 25 to 30 years. High-quality panels experience approximately 2% to 3% productivity loss in the first year, followed by less than 0.50% degradation annually thereafter.

Under typical UK conditions, 1m<sup>2</sup> of PV panel will produce around 100kWh electricity per year, so it would take around 2.5 years to "pay back" the energy cost of the panel. PV panels have an expected life of least 25 to 30 years, so even under UK conditions a PV panel will generate many times more energy than was needed to manufacture it.
