How many solar PV installations are there in the UK?

The total installed solar photovoltaic capacity across all constituencies in the UK is 5,024.3 MW. 1,404,409 domestic solar PV installations across the UK contribute to this figure. South Cambridgeshire has the highest installed capacity, at 27.6 MW, but Torrington and West Devon follow closely, with 23.1 MW each.

How many solar panels are installed per month?

More solar panel systems are being installed now per month than at any time since 2015. There have been 371,000 solar panel installations since January 2022, which has grown the proportion of UK households with solar panels from 3.5% to 5%.

Most solar companies can install a rooftop residential solar panel installation in one to three days, depending on how many panels you're installing and how complicated the installation is. If you're installing a large commercial solar panel system, expect the installation to take anywhere from a week to a couple of months.

The average cost for one 400W solar panel is between \$250 and \$360 when it's installed as part of a rooftop solar array. This boils down to \$0.625 to \$0.72 per watt for panels purchased through a full-service solar company.
