Do solar panels come with a solar connector?

Solar panels do not always come with the solar connector attached. Attaching a solar panel connector to a PV wire is a two-step process: (1) crimping and (2) tightening the connector, to do this you require a wire stripper, crimping tool, and a solar panel connector assembly tool.

How to add Solar connectors to PV wires?

The steps to add solar connectors to PV wires are the following: Strip the wire. Place the connecting plate on it and use the crimping tool. Insert the lower components of the connector (terminal cover, strain reliever, and compression sleeve). Insert the upper components (safety foil, male/female MC4 connector housing, O-ring).

How to connect solar panels to inverter?

Most solar panels have special connectors called MC4 connectors. They help you connect the panels easily. You just have to join the connectors from one panel to the next. After connecting all your panels, you need to connect them to the inverter. This is where the electricity changes from DC to AC, which your house can use.
