



How to remove the solar lampshade and bracket

How do you remove a light cover?

For a light cover with clips, hold the glass dome and remove the loose clip first, then remove the glass dome. For a can light cover, gently pull down or use a spackle knife to remove the entire cover then pinch the wires to remove it completely. For a fluorescent light cover, push the rectangle up and pull out slightly to get it over the lip.

The shade and brackets come pre-mounted inside the valance. Before installing, remove the shade from the brackets. To remove, slightly lift the shade on the motor side and push the shade in the direction of the opposite bracket. [FIG 1] Note: Your brackets must be securely attached to the mounting surface.

With these easy steps, you can now safely remove a lampshade from your lamp without causing any damage.

All our Tiffany Lamp Bases are supplied with either a harp or rod that has the 10mm rod. If we have a 27 or 45 mm thread it is still possible to fit a Tiffany shade, you will need to buy either the harp and stirup (this will mean the lamp has to be rewired) or a harp adaptor that fits either the 27 or 45 mm thread.

A lamp shade can be too big for a lamp, causing a top-heavy look. However, an undersized lamp shade will almost always look worse than an oversized lamp shade. After installing the lamp shade, take a step back to view the lamp's overall look to ensure the size of the shade fits the size of the lamp.

4. Remove Cover Completely. To remove the cover completely, pinch the spring clip together and it will slide out of the attachment. Do this with the wire on the other side and your light cover will be free for cleaning and replacement. How to Remove Fluorescent Light Covers.
