To wash an ostrich feather duster: Fill a sink with warm water and a tiny amount of mild dishwashing liquid. Place the duster in the solution and gently swirl it back and forth until all the feathers are separated. Rinse the feather duster in clean water and gently squeeze out excess water by hand.

Also, try to avoid using abrasive powders or detergents while cleaning the panels as these may streak the glass of the panels. Use of abrasive powders can also create scratches on the panels. If your solar panels are of good quality, you could clean the panels with clean water and scrub them using a soft sponge or brush.
