Are wall-mounted solar panels a viable alternative to a roof?

Can solar panels be mounted vertically on a wall?

How does a solar panel installation work?

The installer will have to lift some of the roof tiles to fix the anchors to the rafters in the loft. Once the roof anchors have been fixed to the property, the installer will attach the solar panel mounting system to them.

What is a solar PV installation?

The confusion comes in as a solar PV installation is often much more than electrical work, for example some installations involve major roofing work and other structural changes especially when integrating photovoltaics into a building's fabric. This work goes beyond Part P and electrical installations, we are now talking about building work.

Can solar panels be installed on walls?

Rules and regulations vary across different locations. In the UK, where I live, according to the planning portal, installing solar panels and equipment on residential buildings is categorised as permitted development. Mounting panels on walls is not optimal for year-round production.

Do you need planning permission to install solar panels on your roof?

One example that caught our eyes, New York installer Quixotic Systems assembled a 37-kW array on the side of Urban Health Plan's Simpson Pavilion.
