Can a PV system damage a roof?

Roof damage can result from excessive load of snow/rainwater combined with the weight of the PV system. PV systems can move in the event of seismic activity resulting in damage and the potential for fire. The installation of a PV system can introduce new components which may increase the likelihood or severity of a loss.

Can PV panels be installed on a new roof?

Where PV panels are to be installed on an existing roof, consideration should be given to the extra weight they will add. If you are planning to install panels on a new roof as part of a new build or reinstatement, it is important to be aware of the different risk implications of different roof types (e.g. flat vs pitched).

Elevation - the optimal elevation for a photovoltaic installation is 40°; from horizontal. This has been calculated to give you the maximum exposure during all seasons i.e. the low sun in winter and the high sun in summer. Most standard pitched roofs are around 35°; Tracking systems are available which move the panels to track the Sun throughout the day to give you the best ...
