How to fit Venetian blinds?

Luckily, fitting Venetian blinds is as simple as gathering your tools, fixing the brackets and attaching the blinds to the brackets. By following our instructions, you'll know how to fit Venetian blinds in no time. Fitting Venetian blinds should be a relatively easy job, even for an amateur do-it-yourself enthusiast.

How do you install Venetian blinds on uPVC windows?

You simply slip the bracket into place between the rubber and glass. Then snap them into place-- and voila -- your new blinds are up and ready to use. These venetian blinds come in a white or anthracite frame to match the colour of your UPVC window frames.

How long does it take to install Venetian blinds?

The brackets will add 3 millimetres to the measurements given and you'll receive a colour-matched valance that is slightly larger than the blind. It also includes side returns to cover the end of the headrail. Now that you've measured and ordered your venetian blinds, it's time to get them installed. This process will take just a few minutes.

What are Venetian blinds?

These blinds are also known as wooden blinds or aluminium venetian blinds. Venetian blinds are made from real wood, faux wood, PVC and metals like aluminium. They come in a range of stains and colours including white, black, mahogany and cedar. These blinds are a popular choice for bedrooms and living rooms as they add a natural touch.

How do I know if my Venetian blinds are working properly?

Check that the Venetian blinds are working properly by pulling down on the cord. The blinds' slats should be nesting against each other while also resting against the topmost part of the support bar. Climb up the ladder. Ask your assistant to hand the blinds over to you; you may also carry the blind with you.

How much valance do you need for venetian blinds?

For all of our venetian blinds, we deduct 12 millimetres from the width to allow room for the control mechanism. You'll also get a matching valance that is cut to your dimension to cover the headrail. For exact blind measurements, also known as outside the recess, you'll need to decide where to mount the blinds.

Position the brackets: Hold the mounting brackets inside the window frame, ensuring they are level and evenly spaced apart. Mark the screw holes: Once you've determined the placement of the brackets, use a pencil to

mark the positions of the screw holes on the window frame.

Before inserting the headrail into the mounting brackets, hook the valance clips onto the headrail. You will need to attach the valance once the headrail has been inserted into the mounting brackets.

Step 5. Unwind the cords from the control end. Holding the blind closed align the front of the headrail to the brackets and tilt the base outwards to allow the headrail to "hook" onto the front of each bracket.

1) Set them slightly back from the glass so the blind has room to run smoothly. Use the bracket as a template to mark the screw holes. Then pre-drill the holes and screw the brackets into place. If the window cavity is wide, it's a good idea to include a bracket in the middle to support the weight of the blind.

Position outer brackets approximately 100mm from the edge of the blind and space the remaining brackets evenly across the width of the blind. (make sure the brackets will not interfere with the operation of the tilt mechanism before ...

4 · Slide the mounting brackets on each end of the blind headrail. Then position the blind on the wall, and align center marks. Mark the position of your mounting brackets with a pencil. make it easier to fasten your screws, create starter holes by tapping a screw with a hammer or using a drill bit. Now, remove mounting brackets from the blind.

1. Install the mounting brackets. Position the mounting brackets approximately 50mm from each end (left and right) of the blind and fix to the wall or architrave with the screws provided. An extra mounting bracket is required for blinds exceeding 1200mm width. This can be positioned in the centre, between the two side brackets.

Centre brackets (if supplied) Screws (if supplied) If the blind includes centre brackets space them evenly between the end brackets being careful to ensure that they do not line up with the strings in the top of the blind when installed. Ensure that the backs of the centre brackets are in line with the back of the left and right brackets.
