What is the voltage output of a solar panel?

You only need to sum up all the voltages of the individual photovoltaic cells (since they are wired in series, instead of wires in parallel).

Nominal voltage is an approximate solar panel voltage that can help you match equipment. The voltage is usually based on the nominal voltages of appliances connected to the solar panel, including but not limited to inverters, batteries, charge controllers, loads, and other solar panels.
